An Amazing 2023 at Centro Multicultural



Responding to our mission of providing culturally-responsive support services to families in a holistic approach in order to improve their quality of life, Centro Multicultural La Familia offered uninterrupted services to Oakland, Macomb and Wayne counties residents in the following languages: Spanish, Portuguese and English.

Victims of Crimes Services

Our team of culturally sensitive Client Advocates is dedicated to serving and empowering families through advocacy and empowerment sessions in the areas of Sexual Assault, Domestic Violence, Intimate Partner Violence and Stalking. As a result a total of **106** clients were served through this year. In addition **365** clients joined our Wellness Workshops. These workshops included topics such as selfcare, employment skills, how to de-clutter our lives, mindfulness wellness and more.

Éxito Educativo

The program's success in 2023 is truly commendable, as it has positively influenced over **100** family members by making postsecondary education seem attainable. Additionally, the admission of more than **50** high school students to higher educational institutions is a significant achievement. Moreover, the fact that **30** students were awarded scholarships and grants underscores the program's impact on facilitating access to education for deserving individuals. This success story is not only beneficial for Latinx students but also for the broader Pontiac community and its surrounding areas. By empowering students through education, the program is contributing to the enhancement of society and the promotion of opportunities for all.

Mental Health

Our bilingual staff offers specialized counseling services for children, adolescents, adults and families in the areas of mental health, depression, anxiety and other issues. In 2023, our organization had the privilege of serving approximately **360** clients through our solution-focused therapy approach, aimed at enhancing their quality of life and overall well-being. Among the individuals we assisted, around **139** clients were young individuals, highlighting the importance of early intervention and support for mental health issues among the youth.











Health Team

In partnership with Ventanilla de Salud, Centro offers various health programs and workshops throughout the community. All programs are bilingual and cover health concerns such as diabetes, hypertension, breast cancer, prostate cancer, depression, anxiety, HIV testing, etc. Events include health fairs, vaccination clinics and resource drives. In 2023 we served 1,011 people. In the area of health we served 8,641 individuals, 1,680 adults and children were vaccinated and we referred 1,199 people to health services. We assisted 658 clients with Health coverage with an enrollment size of 3,129 people.



Small Business

50 businesses, helping improve Financial Literacy in the community and learning how to create and run a business through several workshops for owners (mostly women), young adults, and students. One-on-one assistance was also given to more than **200** clients in order to improve their individual financial needs and business operations. During 2023, SBP helped **5** business owners to the process and approval of SBA loans.



Radio Centro

Radio Centro Multicultural is a vibrant platform that caters to the Latinx community and offers a diverse range of topics related to services offered at our agency. In 2023, Radio Centro Multicultural attracted an impressive audience of **2,786,649** listeners from different corners of the globe.

Together with muralist Alberto Marin, a group of 12 multi-ethnic Pontiac youth and community partners designed and painted a mural in Downtown Pontiac. Thanks to funding from the Welcoming America program, we were able to create a mural that represents bringing the community together, seeing one another in our reflection and all being part of the same solar system - the same united front welcoming each other. Each member of our community is a bright light in the darkness that when combined with the light of others, illuminates the sky and promises hope. We really believe this to be true!





MEET OUR SURVIVORS AND VICTIMS SERVICES TEAM



We offer culturally sensitive, English, Spanish and Portuguese language services to help victims of abuse. Our team provides individual advocacy-based counseling and a support group for victims of crime in the areas of domestic violence, intimate partners violence, sexual and physical assault,hate crimes, bullying, teen dating violence, child abuse and other victimizations.

Some of the services provided include:

- Counseling and emotional support.
- Systems-based advocacy.
- Referrals and assistance navigating community services
- Resource referrals to legal services as needed.
- Las Rosas Peer Support Group:This group is for people who have been victims of abuse. It gives them an opportunity to share their experiences and learn new skills and independence.


